ES086/17/18 – PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Ref: DC/17/05675 - Proposal: Householder Application. Installation of retractable mast of lattice construction with beam antenna and amateur radio aerials to a maximum height of 10.5metres - **Location:** The Bungalow, Mill End Lane, Earl Stonham, Stowmarket, Suffolk IP14 5HY

The applicant was present at the meeting. He went through the application explaining what the mast would be used for, its size and positioning.

During a lengthy discussion the following points of concern were expressed:

- The visual impact for neighbouring properties whose views of the countryside would be impaired.
- Possible interference with reception on neighbouring properties' TVs and radios due to the mast's nature for what it was to be used for.

- The power cables of the neighbouring properties would be in close proximity to where the mast would be. This could be very dangerous should the mast fall in poor weather conditions.

It was AGREED: That the Parish Council objected to the application. **Clerk to action.**
